

# Queensland Liquor Laws

General liquor law information for visitors:

- \* On licensed premises liquor cannot be supplied to anyone who is drunk or under the age of 18 years.
- \* People under the age of 18 years are not permitted in nightclubs – the fine for being found in a nightclub is \$1,875.
- \* It is an offence to produce false identification to obtain entry to licensed premises – the fine is \$1,875.
- \* It is an offence to drink liquor or be drunk in a public place. On-the-spot fines – \$75.
- \* Takeaway liquor may be purchased from licensed premises such as hotels, bottleshops and by guests at licensed motels.
